

SHADOW BOX

What you will need:

- Score Board
- 8.5 x 11 Card Stock
- Tear & Tape Adhesive
- Scissors
- Stylus
- Bone Folder (not pictured, oops)



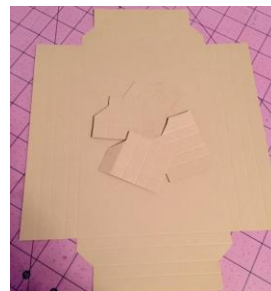
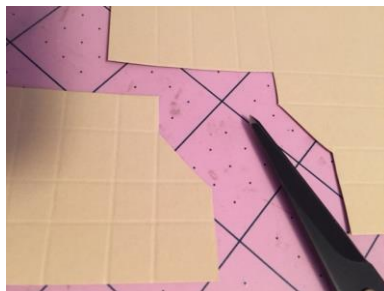
Score all four sides as follows: **1/2, 7/8, 1 3/8, and 1 3/4 inches**



Next on the two short ends score at **2 1/4 and 6 1/4**



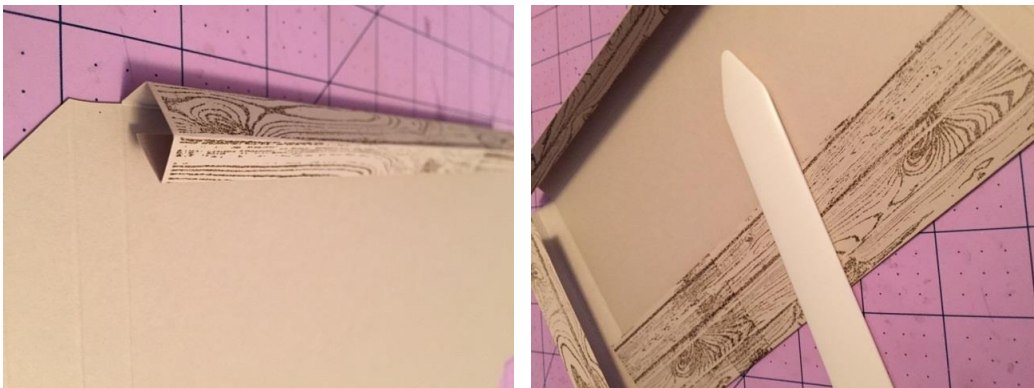
Cut on your short score line. **STOP** when you reach 2nd score line. Cut at a diagonal to your next score line. **STOP**. Then score down to the next score line. **STOP**. Cut the next score line until you reach the end of your cardstock and your corner is **FREE!** Repeat with remaining 3 corners.



If you would like your frame to have that wood look, now is the time to use your Hardwood Background stamp. Stamp only up to the score lines.



Burnish (fold score lines and crease firmly) all score lines.



Add Scor Tape to the Outer most fold on all 4 sides



On long side, remove release paper, and line up the outer two folds with the inner two folds and then fold both towards inside of shadow box and press firmly.



Bring folds to outside and crease to ensure your frame piece is “square”



Repeat with other long end.

The short sides are adhered in the same manner EXCEPT you will need to have the long side laying flat to the outside so its not caught by the tape on the short side. (clear as mud, right?)



Add glue to just the corner of the long end that slides under the angle cut of the short side and seal corners
